INSPECTION OF INSTITUTIONS

1. SERVICE DESCRIPTION

All institutions shall comply with the health standards/regulations (Public Health Act Cap 63:01 and school health manual). Assessments/Inspections of an institution shall be made before occupation and on routine basis. Day Care Centers are licensed for one (1) year and an inspection/assessment shall be done for purposes of license renewal.

2. HOW DO I OBTAIN SERVICE

The customer may E-mail/Internet) call the office or present themselves in person or send someone to register/book for an assessment/inspection. An assessment/inspection shall be carried out with five (5) working days after booking.

3. REQUIREMENTS FOR ASSESSMENT/INSPECTION

The following shall be observed during an assessment/inspection;

- Adequate lightening
- Adequate ventilation
- Provision of suitable waste receptacle
- Adequate and functional sanitary facilities (With adequate running water)
- Status of the building (Crack free floors and walls, intact and clean ceiling, doors and windows to be in good state of repair).
- Storeroom
- Kitchen not to be less than 12m (with necessary facilities, fly screens, dustbin, running water, chimney
- Medicalfood handlers
- Change rooms with lockers

4. WHAT HAPPENS AFTER AN ASSESMENT/ISPECTION

A satisfactory unsatisfactory report shall be issued immediately after an assessment/inspection.

7. SERVICE PEST CONTROL DESCRIPTION

- Control of Pests of Public Health significance by fumigation and bating e.g. Cockroaches, rats, mouse, bed bugs.

8. HOW DO EXPLAIN SERVICE

The client may call, come in person /send someone or use email to report the type of pest infesting the area.

9. REQUIREMENTS

- The area to be fumigated/Bated should be known before payments can be made
- A client has to make a prescribed payment at the Council Revenue Office
- The client has to be assisted within 2 day in district and 24 hours in towns.
- Follow up has to be made in 14 days and re-spraying done if the insecticide was not effective
