HAIR DRESSING: RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. The exhibition is open to **Batswana citizens** only who are at least eighteen years of age (out of school) and above.
2. Artists will only be allowed to register and exhibit at a location where they are based or place of origin.
3. Hair products, tools and accessories will not be provided, therefore contestants bring their own.
4. Wigs, hair pieces and hair extensions are permitted for use, however please note that the judging criterion is heavily based on realistic presentation including believable formation and movement of the hair.
5. Make up is allowed but must accent the style.
6. Draw 3 sketches; the sketches should show front view, side view and back view.
7. Each and every contestant brings his or her own model, however one model cannot be used in more than one category.
8. Each style will be given a specific time depending on its complexity.
9. Each contestant will undergo an oral interview to explain his or her work.
No discussions will be allowed among the contestants once the competition has commenced, failure to do this will result in disqualification.
10. Points will be deducted for pre-prepared hair. Side coaching will result in disqualification and whoever was carrying out that act will be ejected from the venue in order to prevent further disturbances.
11. All products and tools are allowed to achieve a finished look.
12. The accompanying Registration Form must be completed in full and submitted at the regional office of the Ministry of Youth Empowerment, Sport and Culture Development.
13. The jury will award prize-winners in all categories and will base their decision on the Terms of Reference of the Adjudication Form. The decision of the jury is final.
14. Ministry of Youth Empowerment, Sport and Culture Development is responsible for curating the exhibition.
15. No alcohol or any intoxicating substance allowed during the entire competition.
16. All appeals at regional level should be directed to District Coordinator in writing within forty-eight (48) hours from the date of the competition.
17. All appeals at National Level (FINAL) should be directed in writing to the Permanent Secretary within forty eight hours from the date of the competition.
18. Failure to abide by the Rules and Guidelines will automatically disqualify an artist from the competition.
