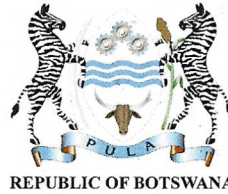

PRESIDENT BOKO TO UNDERTAKE WORKING VISIT TO OMAN

GABORONE, 12th April 2026: President Advocate Duma Gideon Boko, will undertake a Working Visit to the Sultanate of Oman, from 12th to 14th April 2026.

The President's visit to Oman, builds on his Official engagement in Muscat in 2025, which culminated in the establishment of diplomatic relations between Botswana and Oman in October 2025. Since then, cooperation between the two countries has gained momentum ushering among others, a visit to Botswana during 2025, by a High-Level business delegation from Oman.

While in Oman, President Boko and His Majesty Sultan Haitham bin Tarik, Sultan of Oman, will hold Official Talks aimed at consolidating and expanding areas of cooperation between their countries. The discussions are expected to focus on strategic sectors of shared interest including energy and natural resources.

Following their meeting, the two leaders will witness the signing of three key Agreements covering partnerships in the solar energy, minerals and oil sectors. These Agreements are aligned with Botswana's broader economic diplomacy objectives particularly efforts by the Presidency to attract investors and generate revenue for the country.

As part of the programme, President Boko will also visit strategic economic infrastructure including the Sohar Port and Free Zone to gain insight into best practices in industrial development and logistics.

President Boko will be accompanied by Senior Government Officials, and is expected to return to Gaborone on 14th April 2026. In his absence, the Vice President Mr. Ndaba Nkosinathi Gaolathe will assume the role of Acting President of the Republic of Botswana.
